<p>Withdrawals</p>	<p>Withdrawals and refunds will be processed for medical withdrawals only and a medical note will be required to support the withdrawal. Withdrawals for all subsequent sessions must be made at the recorders desk.</p>
<p>Anti-doping</p>	<p>Anti-doping may be in operation at the event. SASA, SE and WASA swimmers will have signed an agreement when submitting their registration fee.</p>
<p>Swimmer Accreditation</p>	<p>Your accreditation will be sent to you by email on completion of your entry. Please print and bring to the event with you where lanyards and pouches will be provided.</p>
<p>Media & Photography Information</p>	<p>Throughout this event Scottish Swimming may have a number of authorised media partners taking static photographs and video footage. These images are intended solely for the purposes of promotion and celebration of the activities and may include live streaming on the internet. Images will be made available to our media partners and uploaded to our website and our social network sites.</p> <p>Should any competitor wish not to be photographed please complete this form. If at any time a competitor wishes a static image to be removed from our website, 7 days' notice must be given to Scottish Swimming after which the data will be removed.</p> <p>By attending the event either as a participant, volunteer, team staff or spectator, you accept that any photographs / videos taken will not be used for illicit purposes or that pictures / films produced will not be altered in any way or uploaded onto the web without the consent in writing of the person(s) photographed / filmed. <p>Protests and Appeals</p>	<p>WPS Rule 10.12 governs the management of Technical Protests. Whilst for this event the WPS procedure contained within will be followed, the fees referred to in rules 10.12.2 d and 10.12.6.2 shall in both cases be replaced by the protest fee and appeal fee each being £25.</p>
<p>Team Staff Accreditation</p>	<p>All team staff must apply for accreditation. Full Meet £10.00 Application deadline: 14.00 Thursday 17th November 2022 Late applications may be considered All accreditations must be printed and worn by all team personnel and made visible at all times.</p> <p>Accreditation for Support Staff will only be permitted for swimmers in the following classes: S1, S2, S3, S4 and S11. Such attendants will be excluded from any restrictions and will be given the same accreditation as the swimmer for whom they have personal care responsibilities. Accreditations are free in this instance providing the athlete, they are supporting, has Code of Exception A, Y or T. Support Staff on the Field of Play with an athlete, when no A/Y/T exception code is present, may result in the athlete being disqualified.</p>

<p>Applying for Accreditation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All applications must be submitted online, you can find more information which will be available from Friday 7th October, by clicking here • Please Note: All team staff accreditation must be confirmed by the Head Club/Team coach as detailed on the online application form • All applicants MUST be PVG/CRB/DBS checked through either: Scottish Swimming/Swim England/Swim Wales. It is the responsibility of the Club/Coach to ensure that, if they require their swimmers to have coach/chaperone representation on the poolside, their application is made in good time and that the relevant PVG/Criminal Records Bureau (CRB)/Disclosure & Barring Service(DBS) forms have been completed and sent to the Scottish Swimming/Swim England/Swim Wales office(s) • Scottish Swimming will not issue any Team Staff Accreditation unless a person has a valid PVG/CRB/DBS through the Scottish Swimming/Swim England/Swim Wales. In-line with current legislation, valid PVG/CRB/DBS from any other agency, will not be accepted. • If you have any queries regarding PVG/CRB/DBS certification, please contact your Governing Body or Scottish Swimming via email to wellbeingprotection@scottishswimming.com • Applicants must ensure a recent photograph (jpeg format) is uploaded at time of application. Previous applicants need not submit a photograph unless their appearance has changed dramatically, or they wish to update the photograph held on file.
