Awards	Best in Group awards The Norrie Beattie Trophy The Elizabeth McCallum Trophy Brogan Trophies Speedo Trophies Speedo Trophy Sandy Galletly Trophy City of Glasgow Scottish Club Championship Cup Medals will be awarded down to 3 rd place and can be collected at the front desk during the session. The desk will only be open for 15 minutes after the end of the final session of each day for the collection of medals. The 'City of Glasgow' Championship Cup will be awarded to the Scottish Club with the highest total of points accumulated in all individual and relay swims. For this club trophy, X Age group swimmer's points will be included. Points: Individual and Relay. 1 st – 10, 2 nd – 6, 3 rd – 4, 4 th – 3, 5 th – 2, 6 th – 1 combined. In the event of any dead heat for any position, the respective points will be added together and halved. There is no limit to the number of individual entries but there is a cap of 8 events which contribute to the Best in Age Group. The Norrie Beattie, Elizabeth McCallum, Brogan and Speedo Trophies are open to any				
	registered Scottish Masters Swimmer, male or female, who compete in either the 50m Backstroke, 50m butterfly, 50m Breaststroke or 50m Freestyle events. The trophies will be awarded in each event to the fastest Scottish Male/Female swimmer whose placing has been determined by utilising the Age Correction Factor.
