### 2. Qualification

To be eligible for inclusion in Scottish Golf Seniors Order of Merit, a player must:

- a) Be male at birth and be of amateur status as defined by R&A Rules Limited.
- b) Be 50 years or over on the first day of the championship.
- c) Be a subscribed member of the Scottish Seniors Golfing Society.
- d) Compete in a minimum of four counting events.

### 3. Final Placings

- a) All points collected by a player will form an aggregate and this total will determine their final placing in the Order of Merit.
- b) The winner of the Order of Merit will receive the Seniors Order of Merit Trophy.
- c) In the event of a tie for leading places the trophy will be shared.

An additional 40 bonus points will be awarded to players making the cut for the final round of the Seniors Open championship.

An additional 20 bonus points will be awarded to all players making the cut for the final round of the Scottish Seniors Men Open Championship.

Eligible players will receive points relative to their final position in a nominated event.

In the event of a play-off to determine the winner of an event the eventual winner will receive 1<sup>st</sup> place points and other players in the play-off will be deemed to have finished tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and receive points accordingly.
